### Unlocking Your Story—grades 5th-12th

Mini-lesson (a list of possible topics can be provided) and workshop session. Please have students prepared to write.

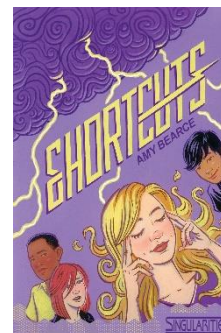
### Writer's Club Visit-- Any age

## I can't visit your location? Skyping is too difficult to schedule for all of your classes? No problem!

I have created an 18 minute virtual author visit that duplicates most of my basic presentation, interspersed with the slides used in my live presentation. Unlike with Skype, you can show this video at your convenience, stop and start as needed, and replay as many times as you'd like. After arrangements are made, I will send you the link to the video. I will follow up with a recorded video of Q&A with your students' questions, up to 15 minutes. **Free.**

## Skype Visits:

For teachers who have introduced my books to their classes, I am happy to do a **free** 20 minute Skype session about writing.

If you'd like to have a more in-depth visit, my rate for a virtual visit is \$50 for a one hour Skype visit. Title 1 Schools are \$25.

## Why do you charge at all for school visits?

Like any professional, authors invest a great deal of time and money in becoming proficient at their craft. Creating presentations takes time and effort away from writing, as does coordinating visits, creating swag like bookmarks to give out, and the speaking itself. Every presentation is adjusted to best fit the audience. In today's world, the majority of authors do not earn a livable income from their books and have another job or other sources of income. Just like teachers, we love working with students, but most authors cannot speak at schools for free, or at least not often. If we did, we would not be able to keep writing.
